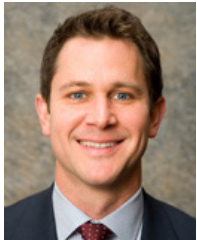


Jeffrey H. Knox, Former Chief of the DOJ's Fraud Section, to Join Simpson Thacher

Knox, former Chief of the Fraud Section of the U.S. Department of Justice's Criminal Division, will join the Firm. In these roles, Mr. Knox supervised more than 100 prosecutors investigating and trying some of the most complex fraud cases in history, including the investigations of global financial institutions for violations relating to the alleged manipulation of LIBOR and other benchmark rates.

Before joining the Fraud Section, Mr. Knox was an Assistant U.S. Attorney in the Eastern District of New York, where he served as Chief of the Violent Crimes & Terrorism Section and successfully prosecuted a significant number of post-9/11 terrorism cases. Prior to entering government service, he practiced at Simpson Thacher for four years as an associate.
